Draper City Fire Department (DCFD) is requesting a waiver from Bureau of Emergency medical services and preparedness.

Due to the First response, but non-transport nature of Draper City Fires heavy apparatus fleet, we request that the following changes to items be included in the waiver:

Remove:

- 1 Short Spine board
- 1 full body immobilization device (pediatric)
- 1 Car Seat
- 2 Urinals 1 female, 1 male
- 3 towels
- 2 blankets
- 2 sheets
- 2 pillows
- 1 Permanent, Large capacity O2 delivery system

Change:

- Instead of 4 – 1000cc of NS only have 2 – 1000cc of NS
- Instead of 5 IV tubing capable of micro and macro drip chambers- have 2

These changes to inventory on the heavy fire apparatus will not affect safety or care that our citizens and patients receive. The items that are removed from heavy apparatus will become available upon the arrival of the transporting unit.
